**Position Title: Communication Action Meeting Team (Kingston)**

**Position Summary:** The Community Action Meeting Team will work closely with Outreach Team, Communications Team, Project Managers and Research Team to host Community Action Meetings (CAMs) bi-weekly across Kingston. These CAMs will work to inform the PAR Research Team and to engage partners in Y2K. The CAMs will foster an environment for young people to work with Adult-Allies to dismantle barriers to success that young people in Kingston face.

**Summary of Duties and Responsibilities:**

- Plan Community Action Meetings across Kingston
- Work with the Outreach Team to determine appropriate topics/themes of the CAMs
- Work on the planning of the Kingston Youth Forum (December 1-2)
- Work on the planning of Kingston's Youth Week (May 1-7, 2017)
